JUNIOR STAR AWARD STATUS

RULES

1. Archers wishing to make a claim must be affiliated members of Archery GB.
2. Stars may only be claimed for rounds shot in open tournaments under Archery GB rules and where an accredited Archery GB judge is officiating. These tournaments do NOT have to be Record Status.
3. Archers who are affiliated to the Hampshire Archery Association can make claims for rounds shot anywhere in the United Kingdom.
4. Stars can be claimed for any 12 dozen round; WA 1440 (Gents), WA 1440 (Ladies), Metrics 1 to 5, York, Hereford and Bristols 1 to 5.
5. Archers must shoot the round applicable for their age and gender on the day of the tournament or higher round as laid down in the Archery GB Shooting Administrative Procedures (U18, U16, U15, U14, U12).
6. The award claimed must be that applicable to the total score achieved (ie. If you score over 1000 you cannot claim the award for scoring over 900).
7. Archers can only claim each award once.
8. Claim forms must be filled in completely and correctly and must be supported by either a copy of the official results sheet or details of a website where the official scores are available.
