Review of Minutes for 19th January 2011 HAA Executive Meeting

Amendment on page 7 which should have stated that the theft of archery equipment was not from Waterside Club premises but from outside the Archer's own home. Reg Press queried page 3 to state that awards would only be presented for Double 720 which would reduce the number of trophies to 21, but it was pointed out that this was already stated in the Target Tournament Organiser's report. There were no other matters arising from the Minutes and it was proposed by David Strong and seconded by Peter Hunton that the Minutes be accepted. Minutes were signed by Chairman.

Reports from Officers

President:

The President had no formal Report but offered his thanks to the Committee for all the work they do.

Chairman:

She asked members to take back to their Clubs that we have nothing to gain personally and all are there to represent our Clubs. It was also stressed that in this day and age extreme care must be taken when dealing with Juniors, in particular if transporting them. To protect both adults and juniors, juniors should be accompanied at all times, whether on or off the archery field, by at least two adults. The suggestion was endorsed by the Child Protection Officer.

The Chairman offered an apology for the "pantomime" at the AGM. Again it was stressed that the use of social networking sites require extreme care and thought as emails and text messages can easily give an impression to the recipient which may not have been meant by the sender. Members were requested to note that the Chairman and other individuals were not there to be abused.

The Chairman concluded her report by wishing all archers good luck with their shooting.

Secretary:

There was nothing specific to report, other than she had made contact with Melanie Ann Sandford who asked for her best wishes to be passed on to all. She has not been shooting very much lately as she is somewhat preoccupied with her bump – the baby is due on 17th July. The Secretary asked her to keep us informed of the happy event when it happened.

Treasurer:

Reported that the books were now up to date. There is a cheque for £500 which has not yet been cashed by SCAS. She had tried to contact Mr Fletcher-Campbell, Hon. Treas., but could not get hold of him. The mail had been sent by recorded delivery so she knew that they had received the cheque. Reg Press was asked if he could make an enquiry regarding this matter and also to mention that, following comment by Reg Press, several members were concerned that very few Officers were attending SCAS meetings. It was pointed out that Officers were volunteers. It was questioned, and confirmed, that this cheque for £500 had been included in the calculation before gross figures had been calculated.

Reg Press offered congratulations and thanks to Louise for getting the books in order, reciprocated by all members present.

Team Manager.

Team Manager Report for meeting held on 14th June

The Team match against Sussex was held on 29th April alongside the Andover Saxon shoot. Despite the atrocious weather, only 1 member of the Hampshire team failed to show up without prior notification. Unfortunately, we had a number of retirements due to injury during the shoot and the weather didn't help the scores. Due to the conditions, a decision was made to base the result of the match on the mornings shooting and unfortunately, on this occasion we were unable to produce our best archery. Sussex won but we will be back next year. The junior match takes place on 24th June at HMS Collingwood and hopefully the juniors will be up to the challenge.

I have had an e-mail from Dorset & Wilts Team Manager to shoot in a team match against them at the DWAA Double FITA 70m on 5th August and I will be looking at the possibility of submitting a team.

We are hoping to host a Junior head-to-head match in the next couple of months and will get details on the web site as soon as possible.

Target Tournament Organiser

The Secretary passed on his apologies that he had not had time to do a report.

Field Tournament Organizer

Herewith copy of results for this year. Thanks go to Raven for staging it, and congratulations to the Champions.

SCAS rep.

Reg Press stated that there was not a lot to report as many Officers could not attend the last meeting, so nothing of any importance was able to be discussed. He was asked to bring this matter up at the next meeting on behalf of Hampshire and to pass on the County's concerns. Peter Turner stated, as Vice Chairman of SCAS, that he knows that Mr Fletcher-Campbell does a good job but has many other duties, thus he is almost impossible to get hold of.

Members were asked if anyone would like to volunteer to be our third SCAS representative, with Reg Press and Ciaran Finn. There were no takers.

County Coaching Organiser

Level 2 course is to held in the Autumn. There are no dates as yet for the next Level 1 course as one had just finished. Pauline Pillans explained that subsidies were no longer available and the cost per person for a coaching course had to represent sufficient funds to cover the cost in its entirety. The cost currently is £250 per person and she explained that if numbers were such that there was any excess paid, this

would be refunded to members. If there were not enough takers to cover the cost, the course could not be held.

Child Protection Officer

There have been no incidents in the County. He reiterated the comments by the Chairman regarding care with juniors. He also apologised that if anyone tried to contact him during the Olympics, there may be a short delay in a response, as he will be on Olympic duty with his job.

Equipment Officer

Due to the resignation of the Equipment Officer for personal reasons, it was proposed by the Chairman that Steve Millward act as Equipment Officer in the interim until formal election for the post could take place at the next AGM. Seconded by Gill Millward? (she said she would have a word with him!). A vote was taken and 14 members voted for the proposal. There were no objections and no abstentions recorded.

SWAY BOWMEN PROPOSAL

The proposal to waive HAA 2012/13 fee to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee and London Olympic Year was read out by the Chairman. Pauline Pillens asked if individual Clubs were to decide what was to happen with the money and it was felt that each Club should make their own decisions following discussion with their members. David Strong asked how much money would be involved and it was estimated that this would total in the region of £6,000. The Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary were asked by Simon Curtis of Sway to confirm that they were in agreement with the proposal and this was so confirmed. A vote was taken for the waiver of the year's fees, with Clubs to decide how to deal with the money, but it was hoped that it would be used for the benefit of archery. Those in favour were 18, there was 1 abstention and 1 vote against. The motion was carried. The Secretary confirmed that an email to all Club Secretaries confirming this would be sent.

CONTAINER AND EQUIPMENT

It was asked for the value of the equipment and container and the Treasurer stated that this was approximately £10,000 for the equipment and £4,000 for the container. These sums were the figures for which the equipment and container are currently insured. The calculation of the sum for equipment had been based on the current Quicks figures to replace the equipment currently owned.

It was felt that more information as to comparison of cost for the options put forward for RNSC hosting all Hampshire Indoor and Outdoor Tournaments with the fee for Hampshire retaining the equipment and container or RNSC taking ownership of the equipment as an offset of the cost of hosting the tournaments before making a final decision. The container would then be sold separately.

It was also discussed as to which choice would be preferred if we had to have equipment and storage put on a commercial site. Two quotes were put forward and that from R J Sillence of £15 per week plus VAT was felt the better option.

As time was of the essence for removal of the container and equipment from its current site, members agreed that an interim measure to site the container and equipment at R J Sillence facility. The Secretary was to ascertain whether there would be a minimum term for any contract for the facility. 18 members agreed, with one abstention and no votes against and this interim course of action was accepted.

Paul Jeram of RNSC was to prepare a spread sheet showing all option costs, whereupon a final decision could be made at the October meeting.

TROPHIES

There was much discussion whether to adopt all medals for awards, to continue with the current system of glass trophy for winners and medals for second and third places, or silver style trophies for winners to be an annual award. A set of badges with plastic inserts were offered for consideration, but it was felt that these did not represent the status of Hampshire Tournaments. It was proposed by Pauline Pillans and seconded by Jean Morris that the award of a glass trophy to winners with badges/medals to second and third places be adopted, as is the current system used. Upon vote for this option, 9 members voted for, 4 against and 5 abstained. This option was accepted.

David Strong proposed that the Committee have discretion to decide whether to purchase enamel badges at a higher price or the plastic cheaper version. Nick Loader has provided information of suppliers and costs for consideration against the current suppliers. The decision will be discussed so that an order can be placed in good time for the next Tournaments. The vote for this proposal was seconded by Nick Loader and 17 members voted for this option which was carried.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Junior Star Awards

David Strong had put together points of requirement to deal with these awards. One point was questioned by Nick Loader that registration was not required as no fee was to be paid. The Secretary pointed out that a Hampshire Archery Association Officer would be required to liaise with Tournament Organisers otherwise the Awards may well fall into oblivion, which appears to be what has happened in the past. After failure of any other member offering to take on the position, David Strong offered to do this until the next AGM. It was clarified that these Awards were for any Junior shooting within the boundaries of Hampshire and not restricted to Hampshire Archers.
