4. Reports from Officers

Chairman:

The Chairman had nothing to report other than to say, "well done" to the Archers representing Hampshire Inter Counties and Hampshire Championships and to Carla Piper for organising this Tournament. He looked forward to seeing more Longbow Archers attending in future Tournaments.

Secretary:

Nothing specific to report other than the usual information provider and passing on replies to enquiries and pointing people in the right direction to gain the information requested.

Treasurer:

Has been chasing Clubs for affiliation forms and fees. We may be able to put some money back into the savings account, which had to be taken out earlier in the year.

Team Manager:

Target Tournament Organiser:

Carla reported a successful Inter Counties and Hampshire Championship Tournament, although was disappointed that more Junior Archers were not entered. She thanked the work party for their help in setting up and dismantling the field, particularly Dan and Julian.

Indoor-

- 1 – Venue booked (deposit paid) - Fleming Park 8/9th February 2014
- 2 – World record status FITA 18 (Sat) and UK status Portsmouth (Sun)
- 3 – 3 sessions on Sat and 2 on Sun due to another booking in the hall (following year should be able to get the hall on the Sunday for longer time)
The hall has to be cleared by 5.00 pm
- 4 – Entry form should be out for the Exec meeting or just after. (I do have other commitments, holiday and National Tournaments)

Competitions-

To promote the sport and continue the podium programme following 2012, I feel that HAA clubs should encourage their club champions to entry the County champs and from this HAA should enter the winners for SCAS or National events.

The only way forward is to push upwards.

Juniors should be seeing the bigger picture and seniors that shoot at Lilleshall are happy to be 20th in an event if the National champs is someone like Simon Terry but he if is missing and they come 18th the place is not relevant.

Field Tournament Organiser:

Nothing further to report other than the usual request for a venue for 2014 to be offered.

County Coaching Organiser:

Supplied by Nigel in his absence:

Over the summer, I anticipated that there would be a level 1 course underway, but the organisation of the venue has not been as smooth or as quick as I had hoped, so another venue will now need to be established before advertising the level 1 course with ArcheryGB.

This is a shame, as I know there are a number of archers who have put themselves forward to attend a course; this is now likely to start in Q1 2014, subject to a suitable venue being found.

Other than this, the summer has been relatively quiet, but I am expecting this to pick up once we get in to the winter season.

Child Protection Officer:

Nothing to report.

Equipment Officer:

No report as position still vacant.

5. Communications

- a) Secretary reported that very few members had voiced a desire to be sent information direct and the remainder of those who responded had stated a desire that information still be sent via Club Secretaries.
- b) Action by Kevin Cassidy to speak with Trevor Smith about setting up the website so that all members could have access. In particular, the security will need to be looked at and a system of how to get passwords to Members. Further investigation would be made to check the feasibility of linking in with Archery GB. In the meantime, communication will continue to go to Club Secretaries. Action by David Strong to liaise with Trevor Smith to put details on the website regarding the Junior Star Awards.
- c) A few members had responded to the Secretary regarding a quarterly newsletter. Of those who responded, all were in favour. Whitehill and Andover Archers reported that they were already running a successful Club newsletter and Vince Verrier suggested that Committee Officers should send their reports to a newsletter. It was also suggested that profiles of Committee Members could be

included. Charlie Cassidy asked if all archers could contribute and it was confirmed that they could.

Action: Kevin Cassidy to arrange to discuss this further with Committee Officers.

- d) It was decided that a trial at the next Executive Meeting should be set up to incorporate an online facility to enable three Clubs (probably the Islands who cannot get to meetings) to participate. This would enable them to join in the meetings and to have a vote, which they are unable to do at present. Julian Piper asked if any of the Islands had shown an interest and it was confirmed that Gurnsey and Isle of Wight were interested. The initial cost for the trial would be £6. If the trial was successful and the Islands wanted the join up to continue, the cost of doing this permanently would be looked into and discussed further.

6. Target Tournaments

- a) Waterside are to host the Longbow Championships. There is a shortfall of trophies and Kevin Cassidy asked for a list of those, which would be needed to ensure that these were obtained.
- b) Details of the Indoor Championships are included in the Target Tournament Organiser's Report above. It was confirmed that there would be 21 bosses with 2 archers per boss, making an availability of entrants of 42 archers.

7. Hampshire Team

A suggestion had been received from Lee Miller and a copy sent out to all Club Secretaries with the Agenda and Calling Notice. The point of this is for clarification and future reference as to what expenses can be claimed and when. Lee's suggestions on the whole were accepted subject to one or two minor amendments. These were to include the statement that the mileage rate be as agreed from time to time; there is clarification of "some financial assistance"; each Team Member will be provided free of charge their first Team T Shirt.

Action: Kevin Cassidy to amend with second draft available to members for further discussion at next Executive Meeting.

8. Coaching

Action by David Strong for Coaching Workshops to be included on website. Action completed.

9. SCAS Representative

Following an offer by Mark Gowing to act as a second SCAS Rep., Kevin introduced the application and history submitted by Mark, as provided to Club Secretaries with Calling Notice and Agenda. Members reported having met Mark at a Shoot and found him to be a most acceptable person. Pauline Hunton proposed acceptance of the position, seconded by Peter Turner. The proposal was unanimously accepted by Members.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Vince Verrier suggested that the next Hampshire v West Sussex Shoot, to be hosted by Hampshire, be a UK Record Status Shoot. Louise Belbin said that this was not normally done. Vince stated that West Sussex do when they host. David Strong confirmed that the history was that shoots were not UK Record Status, but the last three Sussex Shoots were. It was felt that to make these shoots UK Record Status would attract better archers. Carla Piper commented that as it was such a small fee in comparison to the number of members Hampshire has, it was something which should easily be accepted. Acceptance was proposed by Julian Piper, seconded by Ciaran Finn, and accepted unanimously by Members.

The next meeting is the Executive Meeting on Thursday 9th January 2014
