The Chairman requested a minute's silence in memory of Keith Mills, a fellow archer of many years, who sadly died in June of this year.

Review of Minutes for 14th June 2012 HAA Executive Meeting

There were no matters arising and acceptance of the Minutes were proposed by David Strong and seconded by Gill Millward. The Minutes were signed by the Chairman.

Reports from Officers

Chairman:

The Chairman reported that she had been privileged to have sight of the "British Archery Magazine". Glancing through the copy for April 1953 she noted the headline "Wake up Hampshire". Only members from about 5 Clubs had attended an Executive Meeting. Her concern was that the majority of members now attending Executive Meetings still only represented about 5 Clubs in the County. As there are 71 Clubs registered, it was important to persuade more Club representatives to attend Meetings and asked if anyone with suggestions on how this can be achieved should put them forward.

She congratulated winners of all Tournaments and proposed a letter be sent to the Olympic Committee to offer congratulations on the success of the Olympic and Paralympic Games held earlier in the year.

Secretary:

I have received a number of queries regarding Clubs and Courses for Junior and Senior Archers and thank those who responded to help with the enquiries. One call requested a beginners course but not on a Saturday when she worked. Several Clubs responded but most had a long waiting list. There was one very helpful reply from John Wakelin who contacted the lady in question and offered to assist with individual tuition. There certainly appears to be an upbeat in interest from youngsters to join the sport – even some who are not quite old enough but will be soon. I am sure you will agree that this is a very encouraging sign.

Some of you will know Phil Lamb who has been an archer for many years and I understand at one time shot for Hampshire. Two years ago, Phil conquered cancer but unfortunately has been struck with the illness again. He is having chemotherapy treatment and coping with a good sense of humour. I have made contact with Phil to pass on our good wishes and the hope of a speedy return to good health. He thanked me for our message and asked to let everyone know that "you cannot keep a good Lamb down".

It is with sadness that I have to impart the resignation of Lionel Shepherd, our CPO. He informed me that he was no longer able to continue in his role as officer and had decided to leave archery completely. I replied to Lionel passing on regrets at his decision and hoped that we might see him again in the future. No reason for his decision was offered by Lionel so must comply with his wishes that his reasons are personal.

There is the need for a temporary CPO until full appointment can be made at the AGM. Is anyone prepared to take this on please until next March.

On the subject of appointment of Officers, I appreciate that we have another meeting in January before the AGM, but thought it prudent to address this point now. Could everyone please give consideration to the taking on of posts of all Officers including present Officers as to whether they wish to be considered for a further term. I will have nomination forms at the January meeting and can email anyone who wishes to fill in a form. It has been requested that anyone applying for a post submit a short resume of their history with archery. I will need all forms back with me either by post or email no later than one week prior to the AGM, but a reminder will be given in January.

Phil Collins asked if all Officers could provide a short resume of their job description and the Secretary confirmed that she would request this from all Officers.

Treasurer:

SCAS has sent a cheque for £580 as a buffer following GNAS decision to withdraw payment of a handling charge contribution to County. SCAS stated that there was no guarantee that this would be paid in any future years.

The container and equipment has been moved at a cost of £360 removal fee and £18 per week storage fee.

She had contacted Clubs for payment of this year's outstanding fees and there had been a good response. By the end of this week, 71 Clubs should have paid this year's fees.

The savings account with Standard Life had now been taken over by Barclays Bank and currently stands at approximately £21,500. The current account is currently standing at approximately £3,215.

Team Manager:

Many thanks to Nick Loader for standing in as Team Manager at the Team Match against Dorset & Wilts in August. He did a great job and I have had many positive reports back from archers etc.

Congratulations to the Team on their win especially as many of the archers were last minute replacements.

I have enjoyed my time as Team Manager but the past year has proved that I can't put in the time needed while also pursuing my judging responsibilities. I would therefore like to give advance notice that I will be standing down at the AGM

Target Tournament Organiser:

OUTDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP 2012

The County and Open Outdoor Championships were held on the weekend of Saturday 15th & Sunday 16th September at Waterside Archers' Ground at Exbury, where we had good weather throughout the weekend.

The weekend was very well supported with 46 County archers and 24 visitors entered for the Saturday and 77 County and 25 visitors for the Championships on the Sunday. This compared very favourably with the total of 97 entries that we had in 2011.

Following requests from a number of entrants to shoot ends of six arrows throughout the FITA rounds on the Sunday, consultation was made with the Chairman of Judges and the decision to do so using 80cm 6 zone faces for the two shorter distances was made. A number of archers were initially surprised at how small the faces looked at first.

They obviously soon settled into shooting on them though as the National Record and FITA Star claims came in thick and fast at the end of the day.

Claims were made for:

1 National Record	2 Six Gold Ends
4 FITA Target Awards	25 FITA Stars

A number of English Crosses were also claimed, but as these are claimed through their web site I am unaware of the actual number.

There was also much talk amongst the archers of people scoring PBs, achieving MB scores and so on.

Following the presentation of awards, a large number of archers and parents of archers expressed their thanks for a very enjoyable shoot and in the following few days, no less than 27 messages in a similar vein were received.

I would like to take this opportunity to once again thank a number of people, without whom the event would not have been possible, let alone been the success that it was.

Steve & Gill, for marking out the field of play, producing the score sheets & running slips and running a very efficient scoring system, which produced the results within minutes of the shooting finishing each day.

Nick, Lee, Carla and Gill for judging the tournaments

Charlie & Chantelle for performing the duties of Lady P on their respective days

Anybody else who helped in any way, who hasn't been mentioned.

Many of this year's entrants requested that we make it a double FITA Star next year and this is currently under consideration.

I am currently looking at various locations for next year's championships and more details will be given nearer the time.

INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2012

The Indoor Championships are scheduled to take place at RN South Coast Archers on the weekend of Saturday 8th & Sunday 9th December.

The Saturday will consist of two FITA 18 sessions and the Sunday will be the HAA Champs and will be a double Portsmouth round.

Full details and entry forms are available on the HAA web site.

Entries are coming in thick and fast and it looks as though we shall, once again, have a good turnout for this event. All entries so far have been for both days.

Due to the fact that HMS Collingwood is an active Naval Base, it is essential when completing your entry form for this event that you enter details of your vehicle and ALL the people who will be in it, whether or not they will be shooting in the tournament or just watching. Failure to do so may result in access to the base being denied.

Please take particular note of the timings listed on the entry form as hours of access are limited

OUTDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS 2013

The proposed date for the 2013 HAA FITA Weekend is 21st/22nd September. Once again the Sunday round will comprise the County Championships.

Questions were raised of the Organiser regarding the use of small faces and David Strong reported that a County record had been missed by two points which may have been achieved if full faces had been used. The Tournament Organiser reported that the second issue of entry forms contained the information that small faces were to be used and the information also went out on the target list and no query was raised of the Tournament Organiser at the time.

Question was also raised by Nick Loader regarding the use of 3 spot faces which did not accord with GNAS rules and provided a copy of GNAS Rule 4 for clarification. This point would be looked into by the Tournament Organiser and if applicable would be rectified for future Tournaments.

The Tournament Organiser also reported that the Championships did not have world record status as the cheque for the fee had not been received by GNAS in time. It arrived on the Saturday and the deadline for receipt was the previous Monday.

The points regarding the size of faces and the suggestions for rounds at the Indoor and Outdoor Championships were to be discussed further at the 2013 AGM.

The Treasurer asked the Tournament Organiser to let her know how many medals had been awarded at the Championships, so that she could tally the cost into the accounts.

Field Tournament Organizer:

County Coaching Organiser:

County coaching course will be concluding in the next couple of weeks. Level 2 course will begin later in October through till May 2013. The course is nearly full now with the venue in Petersfield.

Coaching workshops will be announced shortly.

There will be a Development workshop on the 27th October on the subject of 'Can you find a paralympian archer'. Venue to be confirmed, but will be notified up on the HAA web site.

Carla Piper asked if Hampshire Coaching supported Coaches from outside the area. The County Coaching Organiser replied in the negative.

Child Protection Officer:

Thanks were given to everyone who had helped with the handling of equipment at the County Championships. Thanks were offered to Steve Olding for transporting the equipment

The Chairman had Junior Star Awards badges available for inspection. She asked how many would be required so that she could obtain information as to cost.

It was confirmed by the members that she be reimbursed for this cost, proposed by David Strong and seconded by Carla Piper and vote carried unanimously. The question was asked as to where this piece of equipment should be kept. It was confirmed that the Equipment Officer should be given it at the end of shoots to be kept with other equipment. If any Judges wished to utilise this piece of equipment, they should contact the Equipment Officer to borrow it and return it to him at the end of a shoot.
